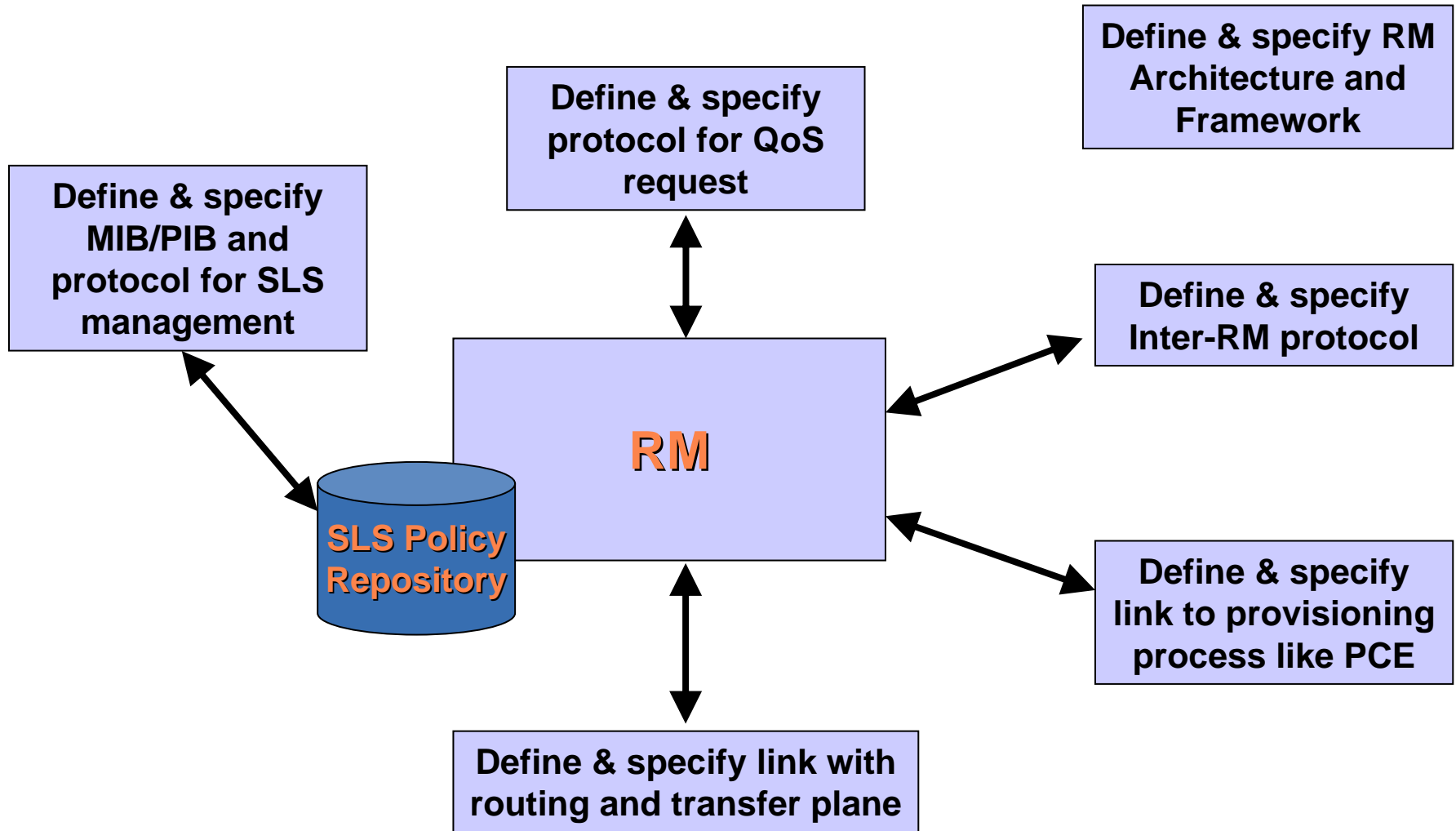

- Several categories of complementary solutions
  - At Provisioning Level
  - CAC based
  - At Flow level
  - ...
  
- But with similar and convergent requirements
  - Need solutions for Inter-domain QoS
  - Need convergent definition and standard inter-domain negotiation protocol for SLS
  - Need link between applications and networks

- Many of us are working in different Forums and Projects on this topics
  - But End2end QoS is not completely addressed in standardization
  
- Study focus mainly on Access or Core QoS in standardization
  - Tispan studies only Access QoS for R1
  - ITU-T NGN Focus Group just starts study inter-domain QoS
  - IETF focuses only on on-path solution within NSIS
  - DSL Forum have recently launch a WT on Policy Control
  
- RACS/RACF/PDF have not their corresponding WG at the IETF

- Preparing a BOF session for the 64th (or 65th) IETF meeting
- Main idea for the Charter
  - Resource Manager box
  - Study protocols around RM
    - Inter RM communication (discovery, peering, communication, ...)
    - Transfer plane to RM information model
    - Service Request to RM
    - RM to provisioning (PCE)
    - SLS policy management
    - ...
- Charter will be carefully prepared
  - To avoid previous unsuccessful BoF initiatives
